Fan Behavior & Sportsmanship Guidelines

Spectators are to demonstrate positive enthusiasm without causing harm, danger or embarrassment to the team, school or others in attendance by demonstrating respect towards all players, coaches, officials and fans, as well as showing pride & respect for their school. Students are reminded that the majority of school rules are still in effect at after-school events & that disciplinary action may be taken for actions at this event. All spectators are reminded that failure to follow these guidelines, or failure to comply with the directions of game or school officials will be cause for ejection from the contest without refund.

FAN EXPECTATIONS

- Limit entrance & exit from the seating areas to deadball situations. Be considerate of those around you; they paid admission to watch the action, not you.
- Profanity, offensive language or verbal harassment of players, coaches and/or officials will not be tolerated at these family activities.
- Obscene gestures and/or the throwing of objects is unacceptable.
- Work with cheerleaders in positive chants & refrain from obscene or degrading cheers.
- Root for your team, not against the opponent. The opponent is not an enemy – they're teenagers.
- During the playing/singing of the National Anthem, all able are expected to show respect to our nation and our veterans by standing still & quietly.
- After the contest, leave the facility in a timely manner and deposit your trash in the nearest receptacle.
